I hereby assume this risk and further do hereby release and hold harmless MACTA, MACTA volunteers, and Johnson County Parks and Recreation District, Johnson County, and the City of Olathe, and its employees: from all liability for negligence, resulting in accidents, damage, injury or illness to myself and to my property, including the horse or horses which I ride.
