

WHITE FOX MANOR "STABLE RULES"

HARD HATS

Hard Hats **MUST** be worn **AT ALL TIMES** when mounted.

RELEASE FORM

Prior to mounting a horse, all riders, including guests of Boarder, must have a current Waiver of Liability Statement on file with the facility's management. Any rider under 18 years of age requires a parent or guardian's signature on the Waiver.

STABLE AREAS

No riding is permitted on the concrete aisles in the stabling area.

Horses shall not be tied to blanket racks or to stall fronts.

During scheduled maintenance, the Arena will be closed to riding.

CHILDREN

All Children (under 16 years) must be supervised by an adult (18 years or older).

ANIMALS/PETS

All animals & pets, other than an equine, must be securely confined inside a vehicle and Owner accepts no responsibility for any animals or pets left inside vehicles.

SMOKING

Smoking is permitted **IN THE DESIGNATED SMOKING AREA ONLY**, which is located in the parking area in front of the main barn.

TRAILER CLEANUP

Muck buckets shall be used in cleaning out trailers, in order to keep the parking area clean.

CROSS-TIE AND INDOOR WASH STALL

Cross-ties and indoor wash stall are for White Fox Manor boarders **ONLY**. You may use one of two outdoor wash stalls located to the east and north of the big barn. Please clean up after your horse when using these areas.

TRAIL RIDING in HERITAGE PARK

Juniors (under 16 years) **MUST** be accompanied by another rider 16 years or older.

It is strongly recommended that no one ride in the park alone. The soccer, football, and softball fields are **OFF LIMITS** to all riders. All jumps within the Equestrian Area in Heritage Park are **OFF LIMITS** to all riders except for those participating in events approved by the Johnson County Park & Recreation District Board in conjunction with the Mid-America Combined Training Association.

OVERNIGHT STALL BOARDING

Overnight stall boarding will be available by reservation only. There is a \$25.00 fee per horse per night payable to JCPRD (Johnson County Park and recreation District) and checks may be placed in the Green folder outside the office located in the lounge area. This fee includes bedding only. You will need to provide water buckets, hay, grain and any fans needed. We do not allow any overnight camping on the property.

The principal rule of conduct at White Fox Manor Stable is to use GOOD JUDGMENT

and display COURTESY & PROPER ETIQUETTE in all situations.

The rules are few, but they WILL be enforced.

ARENA RULES

INDOOR & OUTDOOR ARENA RULES

1. Carefully enter arena to avoid traffic.
2. To mount or dismount a horse, go to an unoccupied area. Go to an area with adequate space without interfering with the work of other riders. The same shall apply to a rider wishing to halt, rest, or adjust tack, girth, or stirrups.
3. Horses shall not be allowed to roll in the arena while other activities are in progress.
4. Be sure to maintain a safe distance between your horse and other horses in the area. An even greater distance should be maintained for beginning riders and horses.
5. Riders walking (or slower riders) should use the outside or rail areas, allowing faster horses to ride toward the center of the area.
6. Riders working on a smaller circle or area should give way to riders working horses on the rail or wall around the entire arena.

7. When riders meet face to face, they should always pass each other left leg to left leg. Always keep to the right.
8. "Ground Poles" are poles in which both ends are touching the ground and are allowed for use without supervision. "Stacked" poles are not considered "ground" poles and may be used in this manner only under the district supervision of a trainer.
9. No one shall utilize any jumps other than inside the arenas.
10. If riders are present in an arena, lunging of a horse in that arena should only be done after asking and receiving permission from those already in the arena. Only well behaved horses should be lunged while riding horses are in the arena.
11. Poorly behaved, untrained, or extremely unpredictable horses should be worked alone in the arena or at times when the arena is not busy.
12. If a trainer is working with your horse, you must exit and view the training from outside the arena wall/fence.
13. Riders 17 years and under shall NOT jump without Trainer supervision.
14. Riders 18 years and older may jump only with the supervision of a trainer or another rider 18 years or older.
